#### Dear Ones,

As the summer draws to a close and fall draws near, there are many unanswered questions that hopefully will be answered soon. Within the next week I and six of the leaders of the church will be meeting with the Bishop. She has many of the answers to the questions we have about how to move forward with the Church. The only thing I know for sure is that it is my responsibility to continue to make disciples of Jesus Christ. Most likely if the Church had focused on making disciples we would not find ourselves in the position we are today. If every Christian would spend daily time in God's Word reading it systematically and studying it, and if we all had made a commitment to spend daily time in prayer and learning how to hear God's voice speak to us, and if we had learned how uniquely God made each of us and we would have employed ourselves to help in ministry weekly, and lastly, if we had been trained how to have spiritual conversations and lead people to Christ, the Church would be strong.

I will once again offer Class 101 "Understanding the Bible" beginning Tuesday, September 13 at 6:30 P.M.. This class will run for ten weeks. I promise you will learn how to understand your Bible. I will give you the tools that will help you. For those who have already taken it, many said it was life-changing. On Monday, September 19 at 6:30 P.M. we will begin a new class called "Contagious Christian." I promise you that by the end of the class you will know how you can uniquely begin using your God-given personality to start spiritual conversations and lead someone to Christ.

When we don't do the four main things God expects of every Christian, the Church gets weaker and weaker. People like to place blame on others about what is happening in the United Methodist Church, but the only persons who bear the blame are those who refused to spend time in God's Word daily, or refused to pray for the Church and the leadership of the Church daily, or refused to do the ministry God called them to do, and refused to be trained in Evangelism. Many of the members broke a covenant they made with God and the Church to "be loyal to the United Methodist Church and uphold it by your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service and your witness."

Long ago God disciplined Israel for breaking the covenant that they willfully made with him. God is doing the same to his Church today. May we learn from past history and correct our ways. Let us move forward and commit to doing what God called us to do so that the Church can grow stronger.


