From the Pastor

Heritage family,

It's always exciting to begin a new year. Flipping the calendar page does wonders to re-energize and re-focus me. What about you? Are you glad 2023 is over? Are you excited about the blank slate a new year brings?

When approaching a new year, I try to be sensitive and aware of what the Holy Spirit is saying to me and the local church. I began praying about our 2024 ministry in November and when I did so I heard the Holy Spirit speak the word of Scripture found in 2 Corinthians 3:18.

And we all, who with unveiled faces reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. 2Corinthians 3:18 (NIV)

This is a powerful portion of God's word, and I will preach on it the first weekend of January. But for now, I want you to focus on the phrase I highlighted: "...are being transformed into his image with *ever-increasing glory...*" Transformation is normal for the Jesus-follower. You and I are being made more and more like Jesus through the transformative work of the Holy Spirit. The word we use for this process is called *sanctification*. God does this work in you. You should welcome transformation and expect it! You and I, however, have a role to play in this sanctifying process. We must put ourselves in the right position.

In our Methodist tradition, we have a phrase describing what it means to "put ourselves in the right position." We call this the means of grace. The means of grace are actions we can engage in that place us in a position to have the Holy Spirit make us more like Jesus. It all begins with a willing heart and spirit where you simply pray, "Holy Spirit make me more like Jesus." But it also includes actions like reading the Bible, praying, fasting, serving, and worshipping just to name a few.

To help all of us experience the transformative work of the Holy Spirit we will begin creating opportunities in 2024 intended to equip you to take your next right step with Jesus.

I'm very excited about the possibilities of 2024 and what it means not only to be a part of Heritage Methodist Church but also the Spirit-led movement of God called the Global Methodist Church. I hope you make yourself available to the Holy Spirit and what he wants to accomplish in and through you as you are being transformed into the image of Jesus.
