HAPPY NEW YEAR! How are you planning to grow in your relation-ship with Jesus in 2026? I hope you're taking time for prayerful discernment. To kick off the new year and provide spiritual direction, we're offering intentional ways to help you Know, Follow, and Share Jesus.

You might consider making new decisions to worship more regularly, participate in a Bible study or small group, or serve in an upcoming ministry. I encourage you to take your next right step with Jesus.

To help us get started on the right foot, I'm inviting you to take two specific actions. These may be challenging and even uncomfortable, but I encourage you to join me. First, attend Sunday worship on January 4. We will be worshiping Jesus using the Weslev Covenant Service, which calls us to recommit ourselves to Jesus in all areas of our lives.

Secondly, I invite you to participate in a churchwide fast on Thursdays in January. Here's what I'll be doing: I will fast following dinner on Wednesday night through lunch on Thursday, which means I will miss two meals. During the times when I would normally eat, I will read that day's SOAP passage and pray. Will you join me from your own home? Imagine a church united through prayer and fasting, seeking the Holy Spirit's guidance for our lives as we begin the new year. Let me know if you'll be joining me.
